CONCERNS, Three possible areas of concern have come up not only this year but repeatedly during my time on the committee

1. It does not specifically say in the policies and procedures that books must be read in order to be nominated. Yes it sounds like common sense but each year someone has not read a book from the list or not read it. I would like this to be explicitly stated in the policies and procedures.

2. There has also been some confusion this year over copyright issues so often books have no copyright but seem to be simply reprints of previous books. Does copyright only apply to books that are newly created or does it also apply to reprints? Or does not applying the copyright to reprints make them eligible?

3. Finally there has been discussion about nominating books in a series. Our tradition has stated that if a book is the first in a series then further books in that series cannot be considered. For example last year the first two books of the Teaching A.I.C.E. series were our first nominees but the next book should have come out in that series in this year were under the assumption that they were no longer eligible as the series was the first this year. But again in this series to be considered and not in writing my here in the procedures.
