VII. Selection of Grant winner(s)

Criteria for eligibility:

- The main author of the proposal must be employed by a state library agency. The author must become a personal member of YALSA or the state library agency must become an institutional member at the time of the submission of the grant application.
- The following must be addressed in the application:

Description and documentation of the need or problem to be addressed.

Who will benefit from this project?

What difference/what impact will the project make?

How will the proposed service/project be provided, delivered or accomplished?

Who will be involved in carrying out the project?

Will partnerships or co-operation with other organizations or agencies be part of the project?

What methods, materials and staffing are required?

Include examples of how YALSA's resources, if appropriate, will be utilized as part of the project.

How will outcome-based evaluation measurements be used to show the

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The recipients of the grant will receive a cash award as soon after Midwinter as is feasible and once the agency signs a memorandum of understanding.

A report on the results of the grant will be due to YALSA one year after the presentation of the award. A reporting form will be made available online.
